1. Routine priority samples must arrive at the Hamilton laboratory by 12:00 PM

For any samples received after 12:00 PM, an additional day will be added on to the turnaround time.

2. Urgent testing must be pre-arranged with the laboratory prior to the sample(s) arriving on site.

Samples requiring urgent testing must arrive at our Hamilton laboratory before 9:00 AM to ensure urgent TAT can be achieved.

If the samples are received after 9:00 AM, they will be processed under routine priority.
